He earned his M.A. in Counseling Psychology at the California School of Professional Psychology in 2001. Over a 15 year period, Mr. Locario worked with American Indian youth in community mental health centers, higher education institutions, incarceration facilities, and reservation communities. In addition to providing direct clinical services, Mr. Locario worked to bring about improve the behavioral health care system for Native youth in California. Mr. Locario also worked at the National Indian Health Board where his focus was the identification and development of best practices with tribal communities. Mr. Locario is currently the Director of Training and technical assistance for the SAMHSA Tribal TTA Center.
