SUBJECT: FY2001 REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

In an effort to keep the Oneida Community better informed about what the programs in GSD do, it has been decided to report quarterly the progress of our programs.

Attached for your information is the 10/17/00 memo received from Donald White, GSD Director concerning performance outcomes reporting requirements.

For the OCHC, I have also attached for your information a list of the Base Line Measures, we identified in our Self-Governance Compact, for purposes of reporting "performance outcomes" to the Congress.
