Re: Tribal Technical Advisory Group Request for Current American Indian and Alaska Native Enrollment Data for Health Insurance Marketplaces

Dear Director Pate:

On behalf of the Tribal Technical Advisory Group (TTAG)¹ to the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS), we write to you requesting an updated report on American Indians and Alaska Natives (AI/ANs) enrolled in health insurance coverage through Health Insurance Marketplaces established under the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (Affordable Care Act or ACA).

First, we would like to express our appreciation for the data previously provided on enrollment in the Federally-Facilitated Marketplaces (FFMs). (See attached reports.) The data covers enrollment at select points of time for the 2015 and 2016 coverage years. These data have proven useful in identifying AI/AN enrollment levels by state, as well as identify problems with enrollment, such as some eligible AI/ANs were identified as not securing the Indian-specific cost-sharing protections. We are requesting a similar report for enrollment of AI/ANs in 2017.

In addition, in order to have a broader and more complete understanding of enrollment of AI/ANs in Marketplace-facilitated coverage, we are asking that CMS/CCIIO provide similar data sets for enrollment in the State-Based Marketplaces (SBMs). We understand there might be limitations on the data that are available from the activities of SBMs. As such, we request as many of the data elements contained in the CMS/CCIIO Marketplace report on FFM enrollment be provided for SBM enrollment. At a minimum, we are requesting CMS/CCIIO provide state-specific data on the number of enrollees determined eligible for the Indian-specific cost-sharing

In particular, the TTAG focuses on providing policy advice designed to improve the availability of health care services to American Indians and Alaska Natives under these federal health care programs, including through providers operating under the health programs of the Indian Health Service, Indian

protections (i.e., zero cost-sharing variation and limited cost-sharing variation) under SBMs. These data would provide a solid indicator of the level of AI/AN enrollment in Marketplaces.

For both data sets, we request the most recent data available.

We understand the many demands on the CMS/CCIIO staff, but we would still like to communicate a sense of urgency with accessing as much of these data as possible. Again, being able to base outreach enrollment efforts, as well as policy proposals, on current and comprehensive data is critical to the effectiveness of TTAG.

Thank you for your assistance with the work of TTAG.
