What is a Health Insurance Marketplace?

The Affordable Care Act (ACA) provides new opportunities for access to affordable or free health coverage through the Health Insurance Marketplace and the expansion of Medicaid in some states. For American Indian and Alaska Native Elders who are covered through Medicare, the ACA strengthens their coverage and allows Elders to take charge of their own health.

Why should I enroll?

American Indians and Alaska Native Elders who have Medicare are considered covered under the Affordable Care Act and do not have to do anything in the Marketplace. But, Elders may encourage their families to enroll in the Marketplace to benefit from health coverage and save Purchased/Referred Care (formerly known as Contract Health Services) funding.

When and where can I sign up?

Open enrollment begins November 15, 2014 through February 15, 2015. Visit www.healthcare.gov to find out your health care coverage options.
