LEGISLATIVE AND POLICY AGENDA FOR THE 111TH CONGRESS AND OBAMA ADMINISTRATION

- Implement NIHB Transition Recommendations consistent with NIHB Resolution
- Indian Health Care Improvement Act (IHCIA) Passage within the first 100 days
- Economic stimulus package:
 - o Include IHCIA in package: Passage would create healthy workforce, create jobs through health professional recruitment and retention authorities, and through health facility construction and infrastructure
 - Health facility infrastructure
 - Hospitals and clinics
 - Youth and behavioral health residential treatment facilities
 - Long term care facilities
- Health Care Reform Legislation
 - Ensure Indian health delivery system is an integral component of any health care reform initiative through Tribal consultation, consistent with NIHB health care reform workgroup key principles
 - o Ensure Tribal input on any proposals to reform the Indian Health Service
- Indian Health Appropriations
 - o Protections from Appropriations Rescissions
 - o Increase in Contract Support Costs
 - o Increase in Contract Health Services
 - o Increase in Health Care Facility construction
 - o Appropriate funding of \$250 million (PEDFAR)
- Elder care issues
 - o Complete comprehensive report on Long Term Care in Indian Country
 - Improve AI/AN access to existing Long Term Care home and community based programs and sources of funding



- Mental Health and Substance Abuse
 - o SAMSHA reauthorization
 - o Ensure Tribal set aside of SAMSHA grant funding
 - o Create a statutory AI/AN specific grant program (similar to SDPI)
- Technical corrections to the Deficit Reduction Act (Medicaid)
 - o Medicaid cost sharing exemptions
 - o Tribal enrollment cards as proof of US citizenship
 - Ensure Tribal consultation in the development of State Plan amendments that provide greater flexibility and expansion of Medicaid services to Tribal communities
- Technical corrections to the Medicare Prescription Drug Act
 - Cost of prescription drugs provided by or through I/T/Us to count towards
 True out of pocket expenses for AI/ANs
- Childrens' issues:
 - o SCHIP Reauthorization and Indian specific provisions
- Health professions/recruitment/scholarship:
 - o Reauthorization of Title VII of the Public Health Service
- Health Disparities/Minority Health
- Veterans' Issues
 - Veteran's Affairs reimbursement to IHS/Tribal facilities for services provided to AI/AN veterans
- Enactment of Title VI of the Indian Self-Determination and Education Assistance Act (ISDEAA): expansion of ISDEAA to HHS programs
