Welcome to Strong Beginnings: the 2nd Convening on Tribal Maternal Mortality Review! This convening will be a space dedicated to continuing conversations from the 2023 Convening on Tribal Maternal Mortality Review (MMR), while exploring new ideas, sharing stories and resources, and concerns about Tribal Maternal Mortality Review Committees (MMRCs).

Attendees will engage in plenary and small group breakout sessions to discuss:

- New initiatives in state MMRCs including AI/AN subcommittees, incorporating a Tribal lens to current MMRC processes, and perspectives on barriers and opportunities in implementing Tribal MMRCs.
